NATIONAL REPORT presented by Russell Gallant

Russell indicated that the National BOG had approved a revision of the Policies & Procedures Manual in March 2018 and the revised By-Laws should be ready for the June AGM. The PPM is being restructured in Modules for easy retrieval by users. Modules will cover National Office policies, Governing documents including By-Laws, Provincial Committees, SSCs, and one on reference materials such as Effective Speaking, Security & Screening. This will take the better part of 2019. The Affiliation Agreement is still a work in progress and will be presented at the AGM.

NB/PEI RCSU(A) presented by LCdr Charlotte McAleer

LCdr McAleer is the J3 Area Elemental Adviser (AEA) for the PE Zone and spoke for the RCSU.

She presented a PowerPoint describing the creation of a Regional Growth Management Tool (RGMT) which is to develop a plan to enable long term growth and sustainability of the Cadet program and assist the RCSUs to manage and maintain the anticipated growth. To assist this, a Management Tool Kit will be developed which will contain a Fact Sheet and Maps showing Cadet distribution and other features. Anticipated roll out for distribution is May 19.

SCREENING & REGISTRATION REPORT presented by Barry Rowan

Currently fifty-nine (59) people screened and registered with PEI Air Cadets. The BackCheck process appears to be working smoothly and each Sponsoring Committee has received the package containing the new forms to be used. The package being returned for a new applicant are the application form, the interview form and the reference form. The names of four references need to be provided, however only two need to be submitted. A selfie-type photo must be emailed to the coordinator and it must be a facial shot taken in front of a light- colour plain wall

It was stressed that new application forms must be completely filled out and a photo supplied before processing will be done at the provincial level.

AVIATION REPORT *presented by* Erik Manchester

The 2019 allotment for flying scholarships is one power pilot training and two glider pilot training. It was stressed to the squadron COs that more emphasis needs to be given to getting the cadets to apply for the power training. This is a unique opportunity that should not be missed.

HONOURS & AWARDS *presented by* Kendra Mellish

Eleven (11) recommendations for Honours and Awards had been forwarded to ACLC HQ and all had been approved. These will be awarded at the PEI AGM in October. Kendra also passed out a number of Provincial League Certificates, see Annex A.

EFFECTIVE SPEAKING *submitted by* Cletus Dunn

The Provincial Effective Speaking competition took place 06 April 2019 in Charlottetown, with each squadron being allowed to have two cadets participating.

The first place Gold medal winner was FCpl Oliver Batchilder of 60 Squadron; Second place Silver medal winner was FCpl Brian Lawt of 60 Squadron; and Third place Bronze medal winner was Cpl Alex Beck of 327 Squadron

FCpl Batchilder will now go on to the National Competition in St Johns, Nfld.

SELECTION BOARDS *submitted by* Gail Lecky

Selection boards were held in Charlottetown 0n the 3rd 0f February 2018. There were seven (7) applicants for two glider pilot training positions, two (2) applicants for one power pilot training and one (1) applicant for IACE. This application was withdrawn before the interview and the position was given to Newfoundland.

Two New Brunswick cadets were interviewed and one GPS applicant was interviewed in Tignish.
